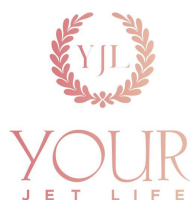

All tickets prices and Prize value are in Australian dollars (AUD), unless indicated otherwise. |

| How will the winner be chosen? | The winner will be selected at random by a representative of NSW Fair Trading from all tickets purchased during the Competition Period. |
| How and when will the winner(s) be notified? | The winner will be notified by phone, email and registered mail. Following this, there will be a sit down with Your Jet Life and the winner to discuss what's required by them, any add-ons, potential redelivery, which extras they want and do not want, and the balance between those costs and the value of first prize would either be allocated to future operating expenses or donated to the charity Angel Flight. |

Conditions of Entry

1. These Conditions of Entry must be read together with the Schedule of Conditions of Entry. By entering, entrants accept these conditions.
2. Entry is open to Entrants who comply with the Entry Requirements. Entries by Ineligible Entrants are not accepted.
3. The Competition will be run during the Competition Period.
4. The Prize is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be redeemed for cash. If the Prize is unavailable, the Issuer will substitute it for one of equal or greater value, subject to any directions from a regulatory authority, and the Prize winner will be notified accordingly.
5. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for change in Prize value between now and the date on which the Prize is transferred to the winner.
6. The additional prize component set out in the schedule are an example of how the balance of the prize value may be taken by the winner. The winner may allocate the additional prize component to aircraft related costs and expenses. The additional prize component cannot be exchanged for cash.

8. All valid entries received during the Competition Period will be entered into the draw and the winner will be drawn on the date and by the method described in the Schedule of Conditions of Entry.
9. If the total Prize remains unclaimed 3 months after the original draw, an unclaimed Prize draw will be held on the date and by the method described in the Schedule of Conditions of Entry, subject to any directions from a regulatory authority.
10. If the full value of the additional Prize components has not been claimed by the winner within 30 days, the residual value of any additional Prize components not claimed will be donated to the Nominated Charity.
11. In consideration for awarding a Prize to a winner, the winner agrees to participate in any promotional activity regarding winning the Prize and consent to their name and image being used in promotional material without payment.
12. The winner will be notified on the date and by the method described in the Schedule of Conditions of Entry and their names published by the publication method and on the publication date.
13. The Issuer may request the winner to provide proof of identity and proof of residency at the nominated Prize delivery address. Identification considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the Issuer.
14. The decisions of the Promoter and the Issuer are final.
15. If for any reason this promotion is not capable of running as planned or if the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this promotion is affected for any reason, the Issuer may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, change or suspend the competition. The Issuer may disqualify any individual who tampers (or benefits from the tampering) with the entry process or the conduct of the competition or who has, in the Issuer's opinion, engaged in conduct which is fraudulent, misleading or has breached these Conditions of Entry.



16. 18. The Nominated Charity is not the Promoter of the Competition or the Issuer of the Prize. The Nominated Charity participates in the Competition only as the recipient of the full net proceeds of the sale of tickets for the Competition.
